

## Tips

- 👂 Look at your picture or photo carefully and think about what you can say.
- 👂 Don't start with details. Make some general comments first, e.g. I think the photo was taken in a classroom/living-room/park, ...
- 👂 Try to mention everything you can see in the picture.
- 👂 Use suitable adjectives. Don't just name the things you can see.
- 👂 Describe what's going on in the picture, but try to say what's going to happen next as well.
- 👂 If you don't know the word for something in the picture, don't panic. Try to paraphrase it.
- 👂 Remember to use the present progressive to describe actions.

### Big picture

- Can you find a "headline" for it?
- What is the picture about?
- Why do you think so?

### Where does it take place?

- Your vague ideas about this
- Explain why you think so!

### When does it take place?

- What time of the day is it?
- What time of the year is it?
- Explain your thoughts!

### What kind of people can be seen?

- What group of age are they?
- What ethnicity do they have?

### What do people do?

- What are the people doing?

### What about the details?

- Don't get lost in too many details!
